

#### Dr. Lord Jephthah Joojo Gowans Named Winner of the 2023 IADR Smile Train Cleft Research Award

Dr. Lord Jephthah Joojo Gowans from KNUST, Kumasi, Ghana, has been honored with the prestigious 2023 IADR Smile Train Cleft Research Award, as announced by the International Association for Dental Research (IADR). The award ceremony took place during the Opening Ceremonies of the 101st General Session of the IADR, held in conjunction with the 9th Meeting of the Latin American Region and the 12th World Congress on Preventive Dentistry in Bogotá, Colombia, on June 21, 2023.

Dr. Gowans has been investigating the role of genetic and environmental risk factors in the etiology of complex disease traits through the use of genetics, genomics, and developmental biology techniques. His research focuses on dental and craniofacial genetics and genomics, including human orofacial clefts...


The project will see the establishment of a Tertiary Low Vision Center on the KNUST campus, as well as associated regional clinics in the Ashanti region around Kumasi.

The two new computer labs and the Human Genetics and Genomics (HuGENE) Laboratories are now fully operational and offer students access to cutting-edge technology and equipment.

According to Dr. Gowans, The lab has three compartments: general lab space, cold room, and cell/tissue culture. The general lab space houses equipment and tools for DNA/RNA extraction, quantification, amplification, and separation/viewing. Equipment and tools for DNA/RNA extraction include water baths, centrifuges, digital vortex machines, electronic weighing balance, magnetic stirrer.....




